WHAT IS IT FOR?

Studying at a French university under a student visa

WHO IS IT FOR?

Doctoral Students:

Single scholarship from 12 to 36 months

Master's students:

Single scholarship from 12 to 24 months

HOW IS IT SUPPORTED?

Doctoral Students

- A round-trip plane ticket Republic of Korea-France and social security cover
- Doctoral Student's monthly stipend: 1,690€ (the amount may change from one year to another)
- Possibility to book ahead CROUS dormitories

Master's Students

- A round-trip plane ticket Republic of Korea-France and social cover
- Master's Student's monthly stipend: 860€ (the amount may change from one year to another)
- Possibility to book ahead CROUS dormitories

WHAT ARE THEY FOR?

Developing French-Korean research collaboration:

- · in all fields of science and technology
- societal challenges, human and social sciences through the prism of science and technology

Fostering the participation of young researchers (doctoral students and post-docs) in research projects.

WHO IS IT FOR?

French and Korean research laboratories affiliated with academic research institutions (universities or research bodies).

Companies that partner up with an academic research institution.

Researchers, postdocs, and doctoral students.

HOW IS IT SUPPORTED?

French grant for the French team:


- Up to 9,500€/year for 2 years
- For mobility expenses: travel from France to the Republic of Korea, hotels. commute. and food-related costs

Republic of Korea grant for the Korean team:

- Up to 15.000.000\#/year for 2 years
- For mobility expenses: travel from the Republic of Korea to France, hotels, commute, and food-related costs
- For other expenses (details on the NRF website)

WHAT IS IT FOR?

Initiate new research cooperations between French and Korean researchers from France and the Republic of Korea, in all fields of science and technology.

WHO IS IT FOR?

Researchers (including postdocs) from French institutions seeking to run a short scientific mission in the Republic of Korea.

HOW IS IT SUPPORTED?

A round-trip ticket France-Republic of Korea, and potentially a few additional per diems depending on the project, the demand, and the budget allocated to this program.
